Antihistamines	Sedation (1st gen > 2nd gen) Anticholinergic SE	none
Opioids	Sedation Respiratory Depression Constipation	none
NSAIDs	GI upset, bleed, irritation, or ulcers	Increased risk of ACV events
Beta Blockers	Hypotension Bradycardia	none
HMG-CoA Reductase Inhibitors	Myalgia	Do not use in pregnancy
Antiplatelet & Anticoagulants	Bleeding & Bruising	none
Angiotensin-Converting Enzyme (ACE) Inhibitors	Hypotension Hyperkalemia Cough Angioedema	Do not use in pregnancy SCr may increase when initiating
Angiotensin II Receptor Blockers (ARB)	Hypotension Hyperkalemia Angioedema	Do not use in pregnancy May increase SCr when initiating
Nitrates (Nitroglycerin & Isosorbide)	Hypotension Orthostatic Hypotension Headache	Do not use with PDE-5 Inhibitors
Insulin	Weight gain Hypoglycemia	none
Antidiabetic: Sulfonylureas	Weight gain Hypoglycemia	none

Antidiabetic: Glucagon-Like Peptide 1 (GLP-1) Receptor Agonist	GI Upset	Pancreatitis BBW: Family/personal history of medullary thyroid cancer
Antibiotics	All can cause diarrhea, rash or hypersensitivity Hypersensitivity is most common with beta-lactams	none
Antibiotic: Flouro-quinolone	Tendonitis Tendon Rupture QT Prolongation	none
Antidepressant	Vary depending on agent	BBW: suicidality in children and young adults
Atypical Antipsychotic	Vary depending on agent	BBW: increased mortality in dementia-related psychosis and suicidality in children and young adults
CNS Stimulant	Insomnia Increased BP & HR Decreased appetite	none
Inhaled Corticosteroid	Oral candidiasis	none
Oral/IV Corticosteroid	Hyperglycemia Fluid retention Hypertension CNS changes (euphoria, mood swings, depression) Osteoporosis Infection Weight Gain	none

<b>Fluticasone</b> Flonase allergy relief (OTC), Flovent Diskus, Flovent HFA, Arnuity Ellipta, Cutivate	CCS	Nasal spray (Flonase) Oral Inhalation (Flovent Diskus & HFA; Arnuity Ellipta) External: lotion, ointment, cream (Cutivate)	Inhaled: oral candidiasis
<b>Formoterol</b> Foradil, Performist	Beta-2 agonist	Nebulizer solution	none
<b>Formoterol + Budesonide</b> Symbicort	Beta-2 agonist + CCS	Inhaler	
<b>Formoterol + Mometasone</b> Dulera	Beta-2 agonist + CCS	Inhaler	
<b>Ipratropium</b> Atrovent, Atrovent HFA	Anticholinergic (inhaled)	Inhaler Solution for Nebulizer Nasal Spray	
<b>Ipratropium + Albuterol</b> Combivent, Combivent Respimat, DuoNeb	Anticholinergic + Beta 2 agonist	Inhaler Solution for Nebulizer
