

Consonants

Most are pronounced roughly as in English. The main exceptions are as follows;

C is pronounced *ch* As in **cheese**

G is always hard As in **girl**

H is very soft Often not pronounced at the beginning/end of words, and between two vowels

KH from arabic words *ch* As in Scottish **loch**

NG is always soft As in **hanger**

R is always trilled As in Spanish

Vowels

There are six vowels (a, e, é, i, o, u) and two diphthongs (ai, au):

a is short As in **father**.

e is the schwa sound. As in **about** or **but**.

é is written as *e* in common orthography. **é** sounds like **bed**.

i As in **green**.

o As in **for** in the middle of a syllable, and **go** and the end.

u As in **moon**.
