TYPES OF PSYCHOLOGICAL PROFES-SIONALS

Psychiatrist - They are the one who specialized the diagnosis and treatment of psychological orders.

Psychoanalyst - The one who specialized the training of theories of Sigmund Freud.

Psychiatric Social Worker - The one who focuses on the environmental conditions.

Psychologist - They can do counseling, teaching and have academic degree and specialized training.

SENSATION AND PERCEPTION

Sensation - This is the detection of physical energy by our sense organs. *e.g.* visual, auditory, olfactory, gustatory, tactile

Perception - Where the brains interpret of sensation information.

Transduction - It converts the external energy using our sense receptor.

Multimodality - Where sensory systems do not always stick to one senses.

SENSORY TRESHOLDS

Just Noticeable Difference - The smallest difference between two stimuli.

Absolute Treshold - Smallest amount of energy needed for a person to continously detect a stimulus.

Red - The long wavelengths.

Blue - The short wavelengths.

Saturation - It refers to the purity of the color that people see.
