

### TYPES OF PSYCHOLOGICAL PROFESSIONALS

**Psychiatrist** - They are the one who specialized the diagnosis and treatment of psychological orders.

**Psychoanalyst** - The one who specialized the training of theories of Sigmund Freud.

**Psychiatric Social Worker** - The one who focuses on the environmental conditions.

**Psychologist** - They can do counseling, teaching and have academic degree and specialized training.

### SENSATION AND PERCEPTION

**Sensation** - This is the detection of physical energy by our sense organs. *e.g: visual, auditory, olfactory, gustatory, tactile*

**Perception** - Where the brains interpret of sensation information.

**Transduction** - It converts the external energy using our sense receptor.

**Multimodality** - Where sensory systems do not always stick to one senses.

### SENSORY TRESHOLDS

**Just Noticeable Difference** - The smallest difference between two stimuli.

**Absolute Threshold** - Smallest amount of energy needed for a person to continuously detect a stimulus.

**Red** - The long wavelengths.

**Blue** - The short wavelengths.

**Saturation** - It refers to the purity of the color that people see.

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
