

Open a registered database

```
$open databaseName.db
```

The database doesn't need to be located in your working directory

Open an unregistered database

```
open databaseName.db
```

open with read and write access

```
open <access read> databaseName.db
```

open with read access

The database must be located in your working directory

Display preferences

```
show v
```

print vertically

```
length full
```

display full length

```
width 1000
```

set width to 1000

Display contents of database

```
cata databaseName
```

display all series in "databaseName"

```
cata databaseName'?stringMatch'
```

display all series containing "stringMatch" in their mnemonic

Manipulate series

```
overlay(seriesB <* to Mar2015>, seriesC <Apr2015 to *>)
```

overlay two series

Query Details About Series

```
whats seriesName
```

returns the class, when the series was created and when it was last updated

```
disp source(seriesName)
```

returns the formula if the series is a formula

Register a database

```
famedbreg -a /tmp/mydb.db
```

register mydb with path /tmp/mydb.db

make sure to set the permissions to 775
