docker container run <container>  
<command>
```

Docker keeps a container running as long as the process it started inside the container is running. Docker does not delete resource by default, so the container still exists in the Exited state.

```
docker container ls
```

```
--all
```

List the running containers.

```
docker container top <container_name>
```

Show the processes running inside the container.

```
docker exec <container_name>
```

```
-it
```

Run a command inside the container.

```
docker container logs <container_name>
```

Show the logs from the container.
