

### quality criteria for requirements

whole sentence Requirements should always be formulated in complete sentences

complete requirements should describe all details

explicit requirements should be precise and measurably

not reducible An application should always describe only the smallest possible circumstances

realisable requirements should be realisable, especially with regard to the given conversion time

up-to-date Each time indication should be absolute and not refer to other things

### quality criteria for requirements

sortable A requirement should be able to be eliminated on its own. This should serve the sortability

traceable Each requirement should have a unique number. This number should not change in the different versions of a document

suitable scope A requirement document should only be as long as necessary to describe the desired situation

consistent In a requirement document, two requirements should never contradict each other

accessible together Requirements should be as transparent as possible and accessible to every stakeholder

standardized structure Requirements documents should be based on a templated structure
