Starting vi	
vi file	Edits file *.
vi -r file	Edits last version of <i>file</i> after crash.
vi + n file	Edits <i>file</i> and places cursor at line <i>n</i> .
vi + file	Edits <i>file</i> and places cursor on last line.
vi +/string file	Edits <i>file</i> and places cursor at first occurrence of <i>string</i> .
vi file1 file2	Edits file1 then file2
Files will	be created when saving if they did

Saving	
:w	Save changes
:w!	Save and ignore checks
:w file	Save changes to file
:w! file	Save changes to <i>file</i> and ignore checks
:n,mw file	Save lines n to m to file
: <i>n,m</i> w >> <i>file</i>	Save lines <i>n</i> to <i>m</i> to end of <i>file</i>

Quitting vi		
:q	Quit (no modifications)	
:q!	Quit and discard modifications	
:wq	Save modifications and quit	
ZZ	Same as :wq
