Quit Emacs	C-x C-c
Pause (return to terminal)	C-z
Recover after pausing (in terminal)	fg
Quit command	C-g

File stuff

Open file	C-x C-f
Open recent file	C-x C-r
Save file	C-x C-s
Save all files	C-x s
Save as	C-x C-w

Text bits

Find replace all	M-x replace-string
Comment toggle block	M-;
Search	C-s

Buffering

Go back/fwd	C-x </>
Switch to other window	C-x o
Switch to buffer/from list	C-x b/C-b
Close current window	C-x 0
Close other windows	C-x 1
Horizontal split	C-x 2
Vertical split	C-x 3

CIDERy REPLy stuff

Start REPL	C-c M-j
Compile	C-c C-k
Reload REPL	C-M-r
Switch namespace to current file	C-c M-n

Cursor control

Start/end of buffer	M-</>
Start/end of line	C-a/e
Undo	C-/
Redo	C-g C-/
Copy/cut to clipboard	M/C-w
Delete line (kill)	C-k
Paste (yank)	C-y
Start region highlight	C-space
