

Test Content

The Bayley 3 is an individually administered measurement that assess developmental functioning in infants and young children between 1 month and 42 months. It measures five areas of development; cognitive, communication, motor skills, social/emotional, and adaptive behavior.

Test Structure

test form **social-emotional & adaptive behavior questionnaire**

cognitive scale social/emotional scale

communication scale adaptive scale

motor skills scale

the communication scale consist of 1. receptive communication & 2. expressive communication

**the motor skills scale consist of 1. fine motor & 2. gross motor*

Administration

The starting points of each subtest is listed in the manual by age.

Applications

- Primary purpose is to identify children with developmental delays and provide information for intervention planning
- Charting a child's progress once an intervention has been implemented
