

How To Ask Questions

There are several ways to ask questions in french:

1. Raise your voice in a questioning way.
2. Add the phrase 'Est-ce que'.
3. Invert the verb and subject.
4. Use a question word.

Question words

| Combien? | How much/many? |
| Comment? | How? What...like? |
| Où? | Where? |
| D'où? | Where from? |
| Pourquoi? | Why? |
| Quand? | When? |
| Depuis quand? | Since when? |
| Quel(le)? | Which? |
| Qui? | Who? |
| Quoi? | What? |

Using 'Quel'

'**Quel**' (*which*) is an adjective and agrees with the noun. Like any other adjective it behave in this way:

Quel = masculine

Quelle= feminine

Quels= masculine plural

Quelles= feminine plural
