String methods

String methods	
print (name.upper())	prints the variable in uppercase
print (name.lower())	prints the variable in lowercase
<pre>print(name.capital- ize())</pre>	prints the variable with a capital
print (name.count("-a"))	counts the number of a's in the variable
print (name.replac- e("n", "m"))	replaces the n's with m's
print (name.replac- e("h", ""))	replaces all the h's with nothing, removing the letter

A method is placed after the variable with a . between them and nearly always end with ().
