### String methods

`print (name.upper())`    prints the variable in uppercase

`print (name.lower())`    prints the variable in lowercase

`print(name.capitalize())`    prints the variable with a capital

`print (name.count("a"))`    counts the number of a's in the variable

`print (name.replace("n", "m"))`    replaces the n's with m's

`print (name.replace("h", ""))`    replaces all the h's with nothing, removing the letter

A method is placed after the variable with a . between them and nearly always end with ().
