Domain-specific language support

Complex event processing support

Version control

Rule validation

A REST API to manipulate assets

Decision tables

Git         Commit facts to Business Central

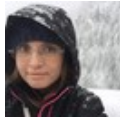
Commit     Git repository, using a developer tool.
