Group assets together as a package

Domain-specific language support

Complex event processing support

Version control

Rule validation

Categorisation

Build and deploy an assembly of assets into a binary package

A REST API to manipulate assets

Multiple types of rule editors

Simple text editor

Guided rule editor

Rule templates

Decision tables

Step 1: Upload the facts to business central

Developer supplies to Business Analyst using either:

JAR file File with facts in Java-compliant format.

Git Commit facts to Business Central
Commit Git repository, using a developer tool.

Steps

Go to Deployment > Artifact Repository

Click Choose file

Find Your JAR file
