FILE SORTING	
CTRL+F3	Sort by name
CTRL+F4	Sort by extension
CTRL+F5	Sort by date/time
CTRL+F6	Sort by size
CTRL+F7	Unsorted

DISPLAY / VIEW	
F1	Thumbnails view (preview images)
F2	File display 'full' (all file details)
CTRL+F1	File display 'brief' (only file names)
CTRL+F2	File display 'full' (all file details)
CTRL+S- HIFT+F1	Thumbnails view (preview images)
CTRL+S- HIFT+F2	Comments view
CTRL+F8	Display directory tree
CTRL+S- HIFT+F8	Cycle through separate directory tree states: one tree, two trees, off
ALT+F10	Open a directory tree window

FILE PROPERTIES	
SHIFT+F10	Show context menu
ALT+ENTER	Show property sheet
CTRL+L	Calculate occupied space (of the selected files)

COMMAND LINE		
ALT+F8	Opens the history list of the command line	
CTRL- ENTER	The file under the cursor in the source directory is appended to the command line.	
CTRL+P	Copy current path to command line	

FILE FILTER	
CTRL+F10	Show all files
CTRL+F11	Show only programs
CTRL+F12	Show user defined files
CTRL+S	Open Quick Filter dialog and activate filter
CTRL+S- HIFT+S	Open Quick Filter dialog and reactivate last-used filter

SELECTIONS	
CTRL+NUM +	Select all
ALT+NUM +	Select all files with the same extension
CTRL+NUM	Deselect all
ALT+NUM -	Remove selection from files with the same extension
CTRL+S- HIFT+NUM -	Deselect all (always files, no folders)
NUM *	Invert selection
SHIFT+NUM *	Like NUM, but files and folders if NUM inverts selection of just files (and vice versa)
NUM /	Restore selection
CTRL+A	Select all

CREATE STUFF		
F7	Create folder	
SHIFT+F7	Create directory in other panel, using name under cursor	
SHIFT+F4	Create new text file and load into editor	
SHIFT+F5	Copy files (with rename) in the same directory	
SHIFT+- CTRL+F5	Create shortcut of files in target directory

ZIPPING	
ALT+F5	Pack selected files
ALT+SH IFT+F5	Move to archive
ALT+F6	Unpack specified files from archive under cursor, or selected archives (use ALT+F9 on Windows 95)
ALT+SH	Test archives for integrity

SEARCHING	
ALT+F7	Find
SHIFT+ALT+F7	Find in separate process

NAVIGATE WII	NDOW
ALT+F1	Change left drive
ALT+F2	Change right drive
ALT+F11	Opens left current directory bar (breadcrumb bar)
ALT+F12	Opens right current directory bar (breadcrumb bar)
ALT+SH- IFT+F11	Focus the button bar to use it with the keyboard
TAB / CTRL +	Switch focus between right/left
CTRL+U	Switch folders right/left
CTRL+SHIF- T+L- EFT/RIGHT	EGEN: Make same folder in both windows
CTRL + R	Reread source window

NAVIGATE FILESYSTEM	
ALT+LEFT	Jump to previous directory
ALT+RIGHT	Jump to next directory
ALT+DOWN	Open list of visited direct- ories
CTRL+PgUp / BACKSPACE	CD
CTRL+PgDn	Open directory/archive (also self extracting .EXE archives)

MISC	
SHIFT+F2	Compare file lists
CTRL+L	Calculate occupied space (of the selected files)
CTRL+M	Multi-Rename-Tool
CTRL+S- HIFT+Q	Separate quick view window (like Lister, but updates with cursor movement)
CTRL+B	Directory branch: show contents of current dir and all subdirs in one list
CTRL+S- HIFT+B	Directory branch for selected directories: show contents of selected dir and all subdirs in one list
