Ethics	ways of making decisions
Morals	codes of conduct that govern behavior (based on values)
Values	what you think is significant and worthwhile

Ethical Perspectives

Moral rules	An action is right if it follows certain fundamental moral rules
Virtues	An action is right if it conforms to a model set of attributes inherent in a particular community
Outcomes	An action is right if the good consequences outweigh the bad consequences
Principles	An action is right if it follows the principles of beneficence, nonmaleficence, respect and justice
Care	An action is right if it acknowledges the importance and value of interpersonal relationships

Types of Questions

Scientific	testable
Religious/Cultural	relate to religious or cultural principles
Legal	constitutional, fines, tickets
Ethical	Should and why
