

### Pronouns

je, tu, il, elle	I, you, he, she
nous, vous	we, you (pl)
le, la, les	the (m, f, pl)
un, une, des	a (m, f, pl)
ce, ça	this, that
mon, ma	my (m, f)
nos, votre	our, your

### "être" forms

I am	je suis
You are	tu es
He/She is	il/elle est
We are	nous sommes
You are	vous êtes (.p, formal)
They are	ils/elles(.f) sont

In English, am, is, and are all have the same meaning. They all mean to be. However, the form (conjugation) changes depending on the person that the verb is used with.

Each of the words above mean to be (= être in French). It's just that the conjugation changes based on the word in front of it (i.e., the person).

### The plural articles

Where are the chips?	Où sont les chips
Are you going to have some olives?	Vous prenez des olives

The definite article in the plural is always **les**

While there is no indefinite plural article in English, in French the articles **des** is always used.

### Conjugation or regular "er" verbs

j'habite	I live
to habites	you (sg. informal) live
il/elle habite	he/she lives
nous habitons	we live
vous habitez	you (pl.) live
ils/elles habitent	they live

To conjugate verbs ending in "er", just drop the -er and add the following endings: e, es, e, ons, ez, ent

### Verbs that end in -er

to live	habiter
to speak	parler
to listen	écouter
to watch	regarder
to play	jouer
to eat	manger
to work	travailler
to fail	échouer
to like/love	aimer
to change	changer
to ask	demander
to stay	rester
to find	trouver
to want/desire	désirer

### Verbs that end in -er (cont)

to keep	garder
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Je is abbreviated to j' when it comes before verbs that begin with a vowel or an h.

These words belong to the large group of French verbs that end in -er in the infinitive, e.g. parler.

These are children	Ce sont des enfants
There are/is children	il y a des enfants
