P. sungas achievements

1) conquest in vidharba: it was ruled by yajnasena who was related to Brihadatta. P. sunga's son agnimitra led the campaign and defeated the king

2) Greeks: defeated the greeks after the fall of mauryan empire

3) He brought political stability after mauryas

4) P. Sunga performed ashwamedha- revival of hinduism after the fall of mauryas

weak king, inefficient administration, welfare

chaotic situation in magadha, military was neglected
