Session View Commands

Launch Selected Clip/Slot	↵ (return)
Select Neighboring Clip/Slot	arrow keys
Select all Clips/Slots	⌘ A
Copy Clips	⇧ drag
Add/Remove Stop Button	⌘ E
Insert MIDI clip	⌘ ⇧ M
Insert Scene	⌘ I
Insert Captured Scene	⌘ ⇧ I
Move Nonadjacent Scenes Without Collapsing	⌘ ⇧ ↑ or ⌘ ⇧ ↓
Drop Browser Clips as a Scene	⌘

Arrangement View Commands

Split Clip at Selection	⌘ E
Consolidate Selection into Clip	⌘ J
Create Fade/Crossfade	⌘ ⇧ F
Loop Selection	⌘ L
Insert Silence	⌘ I
Pan Left/Right of Selection	⌘ ⇧
Unfold all Tracks	⇧ unfold button
Scroll Display to Follow Playback	⌘ ⇧ F

The shortcuts for zooming, snapping/drawing and loop/region settings also work in the Arrangement View. See also the editing commands.

Editing

Cut	⌘ X
Copy	⌘ C
Paste	⌘ V
Duplicate	⌘ D
Delete	⌘ (delete)
Undo	⌘ Z
Redo	⌘ Y
Rename	⌘ R
Select All	⌘ A
Apply to Clips and Slots Across all Tracks	⇧
Apply to Time Across all Tracks	⇧
Apply to the Selected Part of the Envelope	⇧

Tab can be used to move from one track or scene to another while renaming.

Browsing

Scroll Down/Up	↓ and ↑
Close/Open Folders	← and →
Load Selected Item from Browser	↵ (return)
Preview Selected File	⇧ ↵ (return)
Search in Browser	⌘ F
Jump to Search Results	↓

The editing shortcuts can also be used in the browser.



Transport

Windows Macintosh Play from Start Marker/Stop	spacebar
Continue Play from Stop Point	↑ spacebar
Play Arrangement View Selection	spacebar
Move Insert Marker to Beginning	Fn←
Record	F9
Back to Arrangement	F10
Activate/Deactivate Track 1..8	F1 ... F8

Loop Brace and Start/End Markers

Move Start Marker to Position	↑ click
Nudge Loop Left/Right	→ and ←
Move Loop By Loop Length	↑ and ↓
Halve/Double Loop Length	⌘↑ and ⌘↓
Shorten/Lengthen Loop	⌘→ and ⌘←
Select Material in Loop	⌘↑L

The loop brace and start/end markers must first be selected before any of the commands will apply to them.

Adjusting Values

Decrement/Increment	↑ and ↓
Finer Resolution for Dragging	⌘
Return to Default	⌘⌫ (delete)
Type in Value	0 ... 9
Go to Next Field (Bar.beat.16th)	. and ,
Abort Value Entry	⌘ (esc)
Confirm Value Entry	↵ (return)
