

### Navigating the current page

<b>?</b>	Show the help dialog for a listing of all available keys
<b>h</b>	Scroll left
<b>j</b>	Scroll down
<b>k</b>	Scroll up
<b>l</b>	Scroll right
<b>gg</b>	Scroll to top of the page
<b>G</b>	Scroll to bottom of the page
<b>d</b>	Scroll down half a page
<b>u</b>	Scroll up half a page
<b>f</b>	Open a link in the current tab
<b>F</b>	Open a link in a new tab
<b>r</b>	Reload
<b>gs</b>	View source
<b>i</b>	Enter insert mode -- all commands will be ignored until you hit Esc to exit
<b>yy</b>	Copy the current URL to the clipboard
<b>yf</b>	Copy a link URL to the clipboard
<b>gf</b>	Cycle forward to the next frame
<b>gF</b>	Focus the main/top frame

### Navigating to new pages

<b>o</b>	Open URL, bookmark, or history entry
<b>O</b>	Open URL, bookmark, or history entry in a new tab
<b>b</b>	Open bookmark
<b>B</b>	Open bookmark in a new tab

### Manipulating tabs

<b>J,</b>	Go one tab left
<b>gT</b>	
<b>K,</b>	Go one tab right
<b>gt</b>	
<b>g0</b>	Go to the first tab
<b>g\$</b>	Go to the last tab
<b>^</b>	Visit the previously-visited tab
<b>t</b>	Create tab
<b>yt</b>	Duplicate current tab
<b>x</b>	Close current tab
<b>X</b>	Restore closed tab (i.e. unwind the 'x' command)
<b>&lt;a-</b>	Pin/unpin current tab
<b>p&gt;</b>	

### Using find

<b>/</b>	Enter find mode -- type your search query and hit enter to search, or Esc to cancel
<b>n</b>	Cycle forward to the next find match
<b>N</b>	cycle backward to the previous find match

### Navigating your history

<b>H</b>	go back in history
<b>L</b>	go forward in history

### Using marks

<b>ma,</b>	Set local mark "a" (global mark "A")
<b>mA</b>	
<b>`a,</b>	Jump to local mark "a" (global mark "A")
<b>`A</b>	
<b>``</b>	Jump back to the position before the previous jump -- that is, before the previous gg, G, n, N, / or `a

### Additional advanced browsing commands

<b>]],</b>	Follow the link labeled 'next' or '>' ('previous' or '<') - helpful for browsing paginated sites
<b>[[</b>	
<b>&lt;a</b>	Open multiple links in a new window
<b>-</b>	
<b>f&gt;</b>	
<b>gi</b>	Focus the first (or n-th) text input box on the page
<b>gu</b>	Go up one level in the URL hierarchy
<b>gU</b>	Go to root of the URL hierarchy
<b>ge</b>	Edit the current URL
<b>gE</b>	Edit the current URL and open in a new tab
<b>zH</b>	Scroll all the way left
<b>zL</b>	Scroll all the way right
<b>v</b>	enter visual mode: use p/P to paste-and-go, use y to yank
<b>V</b>	Enter visual line mode
