

### Basic Commands

<code>screen -ls</code>	List the currently running sessions
<code>screen -S &lt;name&gt;</code>	Create a new session with a name
<code>screen -r &lt;pid/name&gt;</code>	Reattach to a session
<code>&gt;</code>	

### Shortcuts

<code>Ctrl-a d</code>	Detach from a session
<code>Ctrl-a \</code>	Quit session (from within screen)
<code>Ctrl-a c</code>	Create a new window
<code>Ctrl-a k</code>	Kill a window
<code>Ctrl-a tab</code>	Go to the next window
