

### Modifying rows and columns in a dataframe

Selecting 1,2,4,5 columns from a dataframe

```
df <- subset(x = df, select = c(1,2, 4,5))
```

Subsetting specific values from a dataframe using equation

```
df <- subset(x = df, subset = df$gender ==c ("ma le", " female "))
```

Subsetting specific values from a dataframe using negation

```
df <- subset(x = df, subset = df$gender !=c ("un kno wn"))
```

### Access specific elements of a dataframe

Access column of dataframe

By single square bracket

```
df[" col "]
```

By double square bracket

```
df[["co l"]]
```

By dollar sign

```
df$col
```
