General Rules

4 spaces for identation

Maximum line length 79 characters

Line break before binary operators

Content order: Module comments, docstrings, imports, module globals, constants

Naming conventions	
Package / Module	lowercase
Class	CamelCase
Variables	CamelCase
Global Variables	lowercase_underscore
Functions / Methods	lowercase_underscore
private Methods / Instance Variables	Leading _ and then lowercase_underscore
Constants	UPPERCASE_UNDERSCORE

Blank lines

Surround top-level functions and class definitions with two blank lines.

Surround Method definitions inside a class by a single blank line.

Extra blank lines may be used (sparingly) to separate groups of related functions.

Use blank lines in functions, sparingly, to indicate logical sections.

Imports

Imports should usually be on separate lines

Imports should be grouped in the following order:

- 1.standard library imports
- 2.related third party imports
- 3. local application/library specific imports

You should put a blank line between each group of imports.

Wildcard imports (from <module> import *) should be avoided
