alcohols:

the aliphatic organic compounds containing hydroxyl group -OH , as functional group are called alcohols.



alcohols are divided on the basis of how many hydroxyl group they contain

1) monohydric alcohol:-

the alcohols containing one -OH group are called monohydric alcohols.

classification of monohydric alcohol:-

--->the monohydric alcohol are further classified into three types.

1) primary alcohol

- 2) secondary alcohol
- 3) tertiary alcohol

2) polyhydric alcohol:-

the alcohols containing two or more hydroxyl group are called polyhydric alcohols.

COMMON SYSTEM OF NAMING:-

in common system of naming , alcohols are named by adding the word alcohol after the name of the alkyl group to which -OH group is attached .

for example:-

C2H5OH -----> ethyl alcohol
C6H5CH2OH -----> benzyl alcohol.
