Introduction

Overview of SciTECO as an editor as of v2.0.0. A full language description can be read in sciteco(7).

Legend

- \$ String delimiter (escape key)
- \$\$ Terminate command line
- *n* Some number (implied 1). Usually you can write instead of -1.

text Arbitrary text

- q A named storage area called a Q-register. Use any single character to name the register. There are also two letter names initiated by # and long names in [...] braces.
- $^{\wedge}X$ Ctrl+X, but can also be types with a caret $^{\wedge}$.
- LF Line Feed, ie. Enter/Return key

For instance: -C = -1C = R

Qa = Q[A], Q#ab = Q[AB]

 $Ctrl+l = ^I = Tab key, Ctrl+J = ^J = LF$

| Exiting | |
|---------|---|
| EX\$\$ | Exit, but only if no buffer is "dirty" (unsaved). |
| -EX\$\$ | Exit even if buffer is "dirty", ie. discarding all unsaved changes. |
| :EX\$\$ | Exit, saving all "dirty" buffers. |

| File Commands | |
|-----------------------|---|
| EB <i>filename</i> \$ | Edit buffer or open new file. Files, that did not exist on disk, will not be created until you save them. |
| EB\$ | Edit the unnamed buffer. |
| 0EB | Show buffer ring/list. You can specify a filename afterwards to open a file. |
| n EB\$ | Select <i>n</i> -th buffer in ring. |
| EW\$ | Write (save) current buffer under its current name. Does not work on the unnamed buffer. |
| EW <i>filename</i> \$ | Save current buffer under new name (Save As). |
| EF | Finish (close) current buffer. |
| -EF | Finish (close) current buffer, discarding all unsaved changes. |
| FG <i>path</i> \$ | Go to folder <i>path</i> , ie. change working directory. |

Tip: You can use the Tab-key for autocompleting filenames and paths.

|---------------------------|--|
| × <i>q</i> | Copy from current position until beginning of next line into Q-Register <i>q</i> . |
| nx q | Copy next <i>n</i> lines into Q-Register <i>q</i> . |
| n:Xq | Append next <i>n</i> lines into Q-Register <i>q</i> . |
| nx q nK | Cut next <i>n</i> lines into Q-Register <i>q</i> . |
| НХ q | Copy entire buffer in to Q-Register <i>q</i> . |
| G $oldsymbol{q}$ | Get (paste) Q-Register q at current position. |
| I^EQ <i>q</i> | Paste Q-Register q while inserting text. |
| Е% <i>qFILE</i> \$ | Save Q-Register q into FILE. |
| EQ q \$ | Edit Q-Register q as a text buffer. |
| EQ qFILE \$ | Read FILE into Q-Register q. |

| ^I <i>text</i> \$ | Insert <i>text</i> with leading tab/indentation. Can be typed with the Tab-key! | |

| С | Move one character forward. | |
| n C | Move <i>n</i> characters forward. | |
| R | Move one character backwards (<i>reverse</i>). | |
| nR | Move <i>n</i> characters backwards. | |
