### **Repeat Interval Formats**

Repeat 'Every...'

These tasks repeat every time, whether you complete them or not.

**Every Tuesday** 

Every Monday and Wednesday

Every day

Every weekday

Every week

Every 2 weeks

Every week until 1/1/2018

Every week for 20 times

Every month

Every month on the 4th

Every month on the last day

Every month on the first weekday

Every month on the second weekend day

Every month on the 3rd Tuesday

Every month on the last Monday

Every month on the 2nd last Friday

Every 6 months

Every year

Every year on the last day of January

Every year on the first weekday of January

Every year on the second weekend day of January

#### Repeat 'After...'

These tasks only repeat after you've completed them.

After 5 days

After a week

After 6 months

After a year

### A note about task properties

Tasks that repeat 'Every' create a task series: task properties and notes are common across all instances of the task.

Tasks that repeat 'After' work a bit differently: these do not create a task series, but rather create a new, independent task each time a task is generated.
