Verb_image

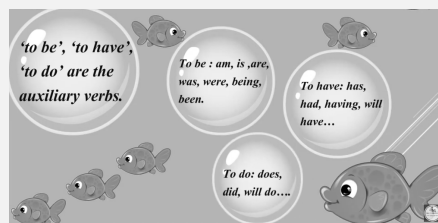
The verb is a part of the predicate.

Of course, we cannot say that it is a sentence of verb.

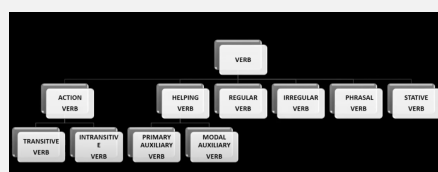
Just it will become a group of words.

Intransitive verb

Intransitive verb is a verb that denotes an action which does not pass over to an object , it expresses a state or being.

Example I play the game in ground

Singular / plural

PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
am / is	was
are	were
has / have	had
do / does	did

Action verbs

Transitive verb It is a verb that denotes an action which passes over from the subject to an object is a verb that denotes an action which passes over from the subject to an object **Direct object** . what ? , whom ?
