General appearance	Tone - floppy?
Physical activity - moving upper/lower limbs?	Posture - should be flexed
Level of consciousness	

Congenital hand disorders	
Syndactyly - webbed fingers	Radial club hand (hand flexed)
Camptodactyly - clynodactyly - little fingers deviated + flexed	Congenital trigger finger - gripping hands - open fingers/hands
Aplasia, duplications and hypoplasia	

Skin	
Milia	Salmon patch - erythema
Angel kisses - back of head	Mongolian spots
Erthema toxicum neonatorum	Cafe au lait spots
Harmangiomas - strawberry naevi	Texture
Colour	Turgor -fluid in tissue, firm
Lunago - "fur"	Nails
Jaundice	Scars
Lymphnodes	

Head	
Appearance - moulding of the head	Shape
Sutures	Fontanelles - size, shape

Eyes	
Pupils, conjunctiva, red reflex - red when you shine an ophthalmoscope	Strabismus, slant of palpebral fissures (DOWn syndrome), telecanthus
Plugging of lacrimal ducts (swollen under eyes)	Visual fields

Nose and mouth	
Nose: Nasal septum for symmetry, discharge	Lips
Mucosa	Palate - high/low
Tongue - frenulum, tongue tie	Suck blisters

Ears	
Position (from eyes to occiput)	Hearing - rubber duck
