

### Infoga Flags

<b>-d/--domain</b>	Target URL/Name
<b>-s/--source</b>	Source data
<b>-b/--breach</b>	Check if email was breached
<b>-i/--info</b>	Get email information
<b>-r/--report</b>	Simple text file report
<b>-v/--verbose</b>	Verbosity level (1-3)
<b>-H/--help</b>	Displays help menu

### Infoga Source Options

<b>all</b>	default
<b>google</b>	
<b>bing</b>	
<b>yahoo</b>	
<b>ask</b>	
<b>baidu</b>	
<b>dogpile</b>	
<b>exalead</b>	
<b>pgp</b>	

### Examples

<b>infoga -d [TARGET]</b>	Search for email addresses from this domain
<b>infoga -d [TARGET] -s google</b>	Search for email addresses from this domain using Google alone
<b>infoga -d [TARGET] -v3</b>	Verbose (level one) output of email addresses found
<b>infoga -d [TARGET] -breach -v 1</b>	Determine if any email addresses found have been found in a breach
<b>infoga -i [EMAIL] --breach</b>	Check if a particular email was leaked in breach
<b>infoga -d [TARGET] -r results.txt</b>	Output results to a text file

### PhoneInfoga Available Commands

<b>scan</b>	Scan a phone number
<b>serve</b>	Serve web client

### PhoneInfoga Flags

<b>scan -n/--number</b>	Specify the phone number to scan (E164 or international format)
<b>scan -n/--number --help</b>	Show options and syntax for scan
<b>serve -p/--port</b>	Specify port number to serve the web client
<b>serve --no-client</b>	Disable web client and use REST API only
<b>serve --help</b>	Show options and syntax for serving web client

### PhoneInfoga Examples

<b>phoneinfoga scan -n '+1(111) 111-1111'</b>	Scan phone number
<b>phoneinfoga serve -p [PORT_NUM]</b>	Spin up web server utility over specified port
<b>phoneinfoga serve --no-client -p [PORT_NUM]</b>	Use API only utility



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
