| Pleuritic chest pain | Tachypnea | Tachycardia |

| Hospital acquired (HAP) | PNA not incubating at admission that occurs ≥48 hours after admission | |
| Ventilator- associated (VAP) | Occurs >48hrs after endotracheal intubation | |
