Clinical Presentation		
Cough +/- sputum	Shortness of breath	Fever, sweat, chills
Pleuritic chest pain	Tachypnea	Tachycardia

Classification		
Community acquired (CAP)	Onset of symptoms begins in outpatient or within 48hrs of hospital admission	
Hospital acquired (HAP)	PNA not incubating at admission that occurs ≥48 hours after admission	
Ventilator- associated (VAP)	Occurs >48hrs after endotracheal intubation	
**Check for possible guideline updates in summer 2018		

CURB-65 Score			
Confusion	Disorientation to person, place, or time	1	
Urea	BUN > 20 mg/dL	1	
RR	>30 breaths/min	1	
Blood pressure	SBP <90mm or DBP <60	1	
Age	> 65 years of age	1	
0-1: Treat as 2: Treat as r >3: Admit to	non-ICU inpatient		



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
