

Installation

```
brew update  
brew install mysql
```

Secure after install

mysql MySQL comes with a script that helps you secure your installation. Run the following command and follow the on-screen prompts

This script will prompt you to set a root password, remove anonymous users, disallow root login remotely, and remove the test database.

Uninstall

```
brew uninstall mysql
```

Starting MySQL As A Service

Start MySQL Service	brew services start mysql
Stop MySQL Service	brew services stop mysql

Start MySQL only when you need it

```
mysqld start the daemon that way the  
start service is not always running.  
mysqld stop
```

Log into MySQL

```
mysql
```

Troubleshooting

```
is MySQL running? ps aux | grep mysql
```
