Uses: Polite requests/ "If" clauses

Formation: ais, ais, ait, ions, iez, aient

Être: ser + endings

Avoir: aur + endings

Past Conditional

Uses: "If" clauses in the past/ Indirect speech ("Would")

Formation: Auxiliary of Avoir/Être in Present Conditional + Past

Participle

Past Participle Endings: é/l/u

"If" Clause Rules

Present--Future

Imparfait--Present Conditional

Plus-que-parfait--Past Conditional

Plus-Que-Parfait

Formation: Auxiliary of Avoir/Être in Imperfect + Past Participle
