# PHOSPHODIESTERASE INHIBITORS

Block enzyme phosphodiesterase

Increase calcium for myocardial contraction

Cause positive inotropic response and vasodilation

Increase contractility and decrease afterload

Short-term therapy only

### PROTOTYPE DRUG

milrinone

(Primacor)

### **MECHANISM OF ACTION**

To block enzyme phosphodiesterase in cardiac & smooth muscle, increasing myocardial contraction force and cardiac output

#### PRIMARY USE

as a short-term therapy of advanced HF

### **ADVERSE EFFECTS**

Hypokalemia

Hypotension

Ventricular dysrhythmias

### **NURSE'S ROLE**

#### ASSESS:

- potassium levels
- for renal impairment
- for dysrhythmias

Monitor for hypotension

IV: Monitor for ventricular dysrhythmias

## PATIENT TEACHING:

Report irregular or rapid heart rate

Report fever of 101 F or higher

Report increase in chest pain

Report fever of 101 F or higher or pain/swelling at infusion site. given
