// comment here : Single line comments
/* comment here */: Multi-line comments

Variables in JavaScript

var, const, let:

var: The most common variable. Can be reassigned but only accessed within a function. Variables defined with var move to the top when code is executed.

const: Can not be reassigned and not accessible before they appear within the code.

let: Similar to const, however, let variable can be reassigned but not re-declared

Data Types:

var age = 23 : Numbers

var x : Variables

var a = "init" : Text (strings)
var b = 1 + 2 + 3 : Operations

var c = true : True or fase statements
const PI = 3.14 : Constant numbers

Objects:

// Example 1

var name = {firstName:"John", lastName:"Doe"}

// Example 2

var person = {

firstName:"John",{

lastName:"Doe",{

age:20,{

nationality:"German"

};
