Hello/Hi	nĭ hăo	你好
Hello (polite)	Nǐn hǎo ma	您好吗
Hello (phone)	Wèi ; Wéi	喂
Good morning	zăoshàng hǎo; nǐ zǎo; zǎo	早上好; 你早; 早
Good afternoon	xiàwŭ hăo	下午好
Good evening	wănshàng hăo	晚上好
How is it going?	nĭ zĕnmeyàng ?	你怎么样?
How's it going lately ?	zuìjìn zĕnmeyàng ?	最近怎么样?
How are you lately ?	zuìjìn hăoma ?	最近好吗?
