Hello (polite)	Nǐn hǎo ma	您好吗
Hello (phone)	Wèi ; Wéi	喂
Good morning	zǎoshàng hǎo; nǐ zǎo; zǎo	早上好; 你早; 早
Good afternoon	xiàwǔ hǎo	下午好
Good evening	wǎnshàng hǎo	晚上好
How is it going ?	nǐ zěnmeyàng ?	你怎么样 ?
How's it going lately ?	zuijìn zěnmeyàng ?	最近怎么样 ?
How are you lately ?	zuijìn hǎoma ?	最近好吗 ?

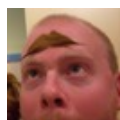
