

### TMUX General & Sessions

tmux	start tmux and attach to default session
ctrl+b	Default Bind Key
bind-key ?	Lists bind-key combinations
tmux ls	prints a list of existing tmux sessions
tmux new -s <name>	Create a new named tmux session
tmux kill-session -t <name>	Kill a session when you're done with it
bind-key \$	Rename session

### Tmux - Windows / Tabs

bind-key c	Create a new window/tab
bind-key w	List windows/tabs (helps on smaller screens)
bind-key ,	(Re)Name a window/tab
bind-key &	Kill current window (confirmation req)
bind-key <number>	Go directly to numbered window
