ff	Search for a file and edit in \$EDITOR
ffp	Preview file and copy the path to clipboard
ffh	Find file and cd there
cd .	Find Dir and cd there
fpop	Display the directory stack with FZF

Package Manager

fapti	Install package
faptr	Remove package

fproj	List projects
ftemp	List templates for work
fchtc	List cheatsheets and cat
fchtce	List cheatsheets and edit
fchto	List org notes and cat
fchtoe	List org notes and edit
fwork	List git repositories
falias	List projects
fdev	List connected external devices
fpdf	List pdfs
ftrack	List tracking spreadsheets
fclip	List clipboard history

Command Line

frm	Remove files recursively
fmv	Interactive mv wrapper
fman	Man without options will use fzf to select a page
fzf-eval	For instance: <code>fzf-eval ls</code>
execut e-fzf	pipe output of that command into fzf
fhistory	Repeat history, assumes zsh
fvars	Search env variables
frg	Find in File using ripgrep and open in editor
fifa	Find in file using ripgrep-all
fimg	Image preview
compress <file/ dir>	Compress one or multiple folder or files
extract <archive_ file - e>	Extract any archive automatically
mkextract <archive_ file>	Create a folder with the name of the archive and extract the archive in

fgl	Git log browser with FZF
fgcom	Git commit history browser
fgs	Show git staging area
