bash	
Ctrl + xx	move between start of command line and current cursor position (and back again)
command 2> file	redirect stderr to file (creates the file if it doesn't exist and overwrite it if it does exist)
command &>	redirect stdout and stderr to file (creates the file if it doesn't exist and overwrite it if it does exist)
command1 xargs -i	uses the output of the command1 as the input of the command2. output will be accessible via {} in command2

bash loops
if <expression>;</expression>
then
[statements]
elif <expression>;</expression>
then
[statements]
else
[statements]
fi
for var in <expression>;</expression>
do
echo \$var
[statements]
done

if <expression>; then[statements] elif <expression>; then

[statements] else [statements] fi
