

### Shortcut Keys

<b>ALT+PAGE UP</b>	Switches between programs from left to right.
<b>ALT+PAGE DOWN</b>	Switches between programs from right to left.
<b>ALT+INSERT</b>	Cycles through programs in the order in which they were opened.
<b>ALT+HOME</b>	Displays the Start menu.
<b>CTRL+ALT+BRE AK</b>	Switches between a window and a full screen.
<b>CTRL+ALT+END</b>	Displays the Windows Security dialog box.
<b>ALT+DELETE</b>	Displays the Windows menu.
<b>CTRL+ALT+MIN US SIGN</b> <i>(on the numeric keypad)</i>	Copies the active window, within the client computer, to the remote computer's Clipboard (provides the same functionality as pressing ALT+PRINT SCREEN on a local computer).
<b>CTRL+ALT+PLU S SIGN</b> <i>(on the numeric keypad)</i>	Copies the entire client computer's window area to the remote computer's Clipboard (provides the same functionality as pressing PRINT SCREEN on a local computer).
<b>CTRL+ALT+RIG HT ARROW</b>	Enables you to tab out of the Remote Desktop controls to a control in the host program (for example, a button or a text box). Useful when the Remote Desktop controls are embedded in another (host) program.
<b>CTRL+ALT+LEF T ARROW</b>	Enables you to tab out of the Remote Desktop controls to a control in the host program (for example, a button or a text box). Useful when the Remote Desktop controls are embedded in another (host) program.
