

### Git Grep - Where a term existed

```
git grep <string>
```

#### OPTIONS

-n show line number

-p show what method/function matches string

--break --heading make output more readable

### git log - When a term existed

```
git log -S<string> <filename> show commits where string existed
```

#### OPTIONS

--one-line show each commit in one line
