

Git Grep - Where a term existed

`git grep <string>`

OPTIONS

<code>-n</code>	show line number
<code>-p</code>	show what method/function matches string
<code>--break --heading</code>	make output more readable

git log - When a term existed

`git log -S<string> <filename>` show commits where string existed

OPTIONS

<code>--one-line</code>	show each commit in one line
