4 Subcategory of Mishap Probability

Sub-category A- Likely to occur immediately or within a short period of time.

Sub-category B- Probably will occur in time.

Sub-category C- May occur in time.

Sub-category D- Unlikely to occur.

4 Categories of Hazard Severity

Category 1- May cause death

Category 2- May cause SEVERE injury, illness, or damage

Category 3- May cause MINOR injury, illness, or damage

Category 4- May cause minimal threat

Define RAC and list the 5 RAC's

Risk Assessment Code is a number expression associated to level of risk

1. Critical Risk
2. Serious Risk
3. Moderate Risk
4. Minor Risk
5. Negligible Risk
