Plain Language Address =
Abbreviations used to reduce message title lengths

EKMS

Used to safeguard highly sensitive communications material

5 Configurations of INMARSAT

ALPHA = 64k voice/data

BRAVO = 64k voice/data

CHARLIE = 64k/128k data only

DELTA = 128k voice/data

ECHO = 128k voice/data

CUDIX

Message system between Afloat Platforms

Tempest

Code word describing compromising emanations from communications

OTAT (over the air transfer)

Transfer of tactical key by way of NATO broadcasts

Gingerbread

Intruder on the net or circuit

Meaconing

Rebroadcasting NAVAIDS to confuse adversary Navigation

Automated Digital Network System (ADNS)

Provides video, voice, and data services to the fleet

Comspot Report

Submitted during communications outtages

Required w/in 30 minutes of outage

DCO

Defense Connect Online

Used to obtain timely sensitive Information by Gov't Employees

EEFI

Info if captured by an adversary would degrade military operations and security

NOVA

Relays messages to other commands outside of the immediate area of responsibility
