Content validity

Does the test measure the conscruct like it was intended to?

Face validity

Does the test give the impression it is valid?

Criterion validity

Can the test correctly estimate results?

Criterion

Every result against which a test can be validated. The result is a validity coefficient.

Concurrent validity

In concurrent validity criterion measurements are obtained simultaniously as the gaining of test scores.

Predictive validity

The criterion measurements are obtained in the future.

Example: grade as a result of an entrance exam.

Validity coefficient

 $Rxy = \sqrt{(Rxx)(Ryy)}$

The validity coefficient is always more than or equal to the square root of test validity multiplied with criterion validity.
