Variables - Naming & Types	
<pre>\$name = " Jim ";</pre>	string
<pre>\$number = 23;</pre>	number
\$Float = 55.67;	float
<pre>\$_included = true;</pre>	boolean
<pre>\$stuff _array = ["st rin g", 44, false];</pre>	array
<pre>\$nothing2 = null:</pre>	null

Naming: Variables can only contain numbers, letters, and underscores, although they must begin with a letter or underscore. They are case sensitive.

Types: Variables can store the data types string, number, float, boolean, array, and null.

Glossary	
string interp- olation	embedding variable value in a string
concatenation	joining two strings end to end
casting	the process of transforming from one data type to another

Variables - Modifiers

Set the value of the variable to its current value plus 5

number += 5

Increment the variable value by 1

\$number++;

Decrement the variable value by 1

\$number--;
