Roaring Twe	nties
Palmer Raids	1920 operation by Att. Gen. Mitchel Palmer, marshals raid homes of suspected radicals and hq of organizations in 32 cities
Nativism	Resurfaced because of fear & prejudice many felt towards German and communists.
Fundamenta lism	Bible = literal true without error
Prohibition	18th ammendment in 1920 until 21st ammendment in 33
Flappers	Radical fashioned women
Art Deco	Art Style of 20's and 30s
Harlem Renaissanc e	1920's when black achievements in art, music and literature flourished
Back to Africa Movement	Encouraged blacks to return to Africa for their own empire because of racists in states
NAACP	Nat'l Assoc. for Adv. of Color Ppl, found in 1909, got supreme court to declare grandfather clause unconstitutional
ACLU	Amer. Cib. Lib. Union - Defendsrights that constitution grants
Jazz	Popular dance music of 20's
18 Amendment	Prohibited manufacture, sale, and distr. of alcohol
19 Amendment	Right to vote to women in federal or state elections
21st amendment	Repealed 18th amendment
National	Made immigrant restrictions a permanent policy, mostly

Roaring Twenties (cont)	
Volstead Act	Bill passed by congress to enforce the language of 18th amendment
Scopes Trial	1925 Tennesse trial of Teaacher John Scopes charged w/ teaching evolution.
Warren Harding	29th, republican, "Return to Normalcy". Marred by scandal
Calvin Coolidge	Rigid economy, "Silent Cal", True Republican, believed in gov't supporting big business and little intervention
Marcus Garvey	Black leader during 20's, founded universal negro improvement assocatian, advocated migration to Africa, deported to Jamaica in 27
Zora Neal Hurston	Black writer, folklore scholar, author of "Their Eyes Were Watching God", sympathy for blacks.
Langston Hughes	Black poet, described rich culture of black life using rhythems influenced by jazz. Wrote of hope and defiance & culture.
Bonus Army	WWI vets that marched to DC in 32 to demand immediate payment, were denied
Teapot Dome Scandal	Oil discovered on fed. land > Contracts given from bribes, total ~ \$400M in 20's USD
Lindbergh	Crosses atlantic solo, instant fame
Mississip pi Flood	Kills 300, caused \$4B

World War II	
Axis Powers:	Fascist Italy, Empire O' Japan, Nazi Germany, Hungary (no choice), Finland (hates USSR)
Allied Powers:	China, British Empire, France, USSR, USA, other small nations contributed
Germany First Policy	UK/US agreement, Germany should be biggest effort because it's strongest
Pearl Harbor	Dec. 7, 1941 - Drew US into war on a sunday morning, missed oil and aircraft carriers
Air War: "Memphis Belle"	First to make 25 bombing runs, so did Jimmy Stewart!
Sea War:	USS Pamponito Submarine, USS Iowa Battleship, USS Enterprise Aircraft Carrier
D-Day	Largest Amphibian Assault, lead by Eisenhower, thousands dead
Yalta Agreement	Agreement to split Germany, Eastern Germany with USSR
Soviet Union Declared Japan War	Last in August 8-9, 1945, rested up and reinforced late
VJ Day	Signed on USS Missouri
Largest Armed Forces	Russia, China, Japan, Germany, US, British Empire
Death Toll:	~60M
Russian Death Toll:	~20M, POW's ~3.3M
London Death Toll:	~85k
Dresden Death Toll	~100-125k, caused form Firestorm
Nanking Death Toll	~400k

World War	II (cont)
Japan Cities Toll	~ 66 cities
Peak of Bomb Drops @ Japan	~37,992 (by August, ~2weeks of petroleum left)
Nagasaki Bomb	~20k Tons of TNT
Atom Bomb Death Toll	Combined ~ 350k
Leaders:	President for most war: Roosevelt, PM of UK = Churchill, USSR = Stalin, Allied Europe = Eisenhower, Allied Asia =McCarthur, PM of Japan = Hideki Tojo

The Great Depression	1
October 29, 1929	Stock Market Crashes - first major indicator of coming depression, dubbed "Black Tuesday".
Smoot-Hawley Tariff	High Tariff contributed to global downturn
1st New Deal	Legislation about Relief, Recovery & Reform
2nd New Deal	WPA/Jobs
SSA	Social Sec. Act - Forced retirment savings
Wagner Act / NLRb / Nat'l Labor Rel. Board	Increasing worker protections, protected unions.
3rd New Deal/ J.M. Keynes	English economist who believed Govt should spend to help gdp
Glass-Steagall Act - FDIC	Fed. Dep. Insur. Corp 1933, insured bank deposits,
Securites & Exchange Commission - SEC	Regulated stock market, restricted margin buyin

The Great D	Depression (cont)
Social Security Act - SSI	Provided pensions, unemployment insurance, aid to disabled and poor. Welfare and forced savings
Tennessee Valley Authory - TVA	Fed gov't built dams for electricity. Still around.
Hooverville s	Shanty towns named after president
Dust Bowl	TX, OK, KS, reason wy ppl movede west
FDR	established 20+ programs, replaced Hoover, Supreme court knocked a lot down, Biggest fear was Facism
Signs of Facism	Irrational Manipulation of masses, Social Darwinism (Supreme race), Natlism on steroids, glorification of state, absolute obedience to leaders, racism, anti-communist
Result of Facism	Universal Propaganda, Militarism, Glorified Authoritarian Leaders, Institutionalized Persecution, Intolerance of ideas outside Fascism(book burning), Resistance in form of minorities

#### WWII Affected Gender Norms for American Society

Because so many males were drafted/joined to fight in WWII, females were encouraged to contribute by working instead of being the typical housewife. Women now gained much more independence. This was slightly combatted after the war due to the men returning and sexist mentalities remaining.

Cold War Costs	~1.5 - 3T
Brandenberg Gate	Symbolic Gate @ Berlin
Korean War (50-53)	First major use of Helicopters
Tito	Yugoslavic leader who kept them independent
NATO	US, Canada, UK, France, Portugal, West Germany, Italy, Greece, Turkey, Norway, Belgium, Netherlands
Warsaw Pact	USSR, Poland, Romania, Bulgaria, Hungary, Czech, East Germany, Albania
George Kennan	Diplomat @ Russia, sent analysis of Leadership, Containment Policy author
George Marshall	Trumans Foreign advisor & Secretary of state, endorsed plan to give aide to failing nationas
Britain continued rations	For 7 years after the war
Truman	lke, great president after FDR
Eisenhower	Came after Truman
Stalin	Died in 53, causing power struggle
Nakita Khruschchev	Next in power, less cruel but still craycray
Chairman Mao	Drove remaining China into Taiwan
Berlin Blockade	Western Berlin surrounded, Stalin blocks land, west air drops

Cold War (46 - 90's) (cont)	
Korean War	N.Korea in old Japan, attacks South. No soviet troops but did get training and funding. Eventually coalition Nato takes seoul with30 nations, China sends 2m, 3 years later, stalemate @ 38th Parallel.
Senator Joseph McCarthy	Gained power by accusing ppl of being red, "Demagog"
Guatemala	US Backed by CIA, rids Jacobo Arbenz

WWII @ Home	
Rationing	Ration food, gas, rubber, etc for troops, a lot of farmers left for war
Recycling	Collected glass, meta, rubber, even fats. Boyscouts recycled Newspapers too well
Relocation	People all over the nation moving towards jobs/ factories
Victory Gardens	Encouragement of small family gardens, 1/3 of all vegetabls produced, not rationed
Radio	Becomes main source of news & entertainment
Includes	"Dont sit under apple tree" - Andrew Sisters, "Report from Paratrooper" by Edward Murrow, "I'll be seeing you" by Tommy Dorsey & Sinatra in 1940
Remembe rance	People wrote huge #'s of Letters, kept pictures
Relocation Revisited	Japanese internment camps created, loss of private property, etc
