Code 20	Notify media of newsworthy incident.

SITUATION CHEAT SHEET

SITUATION RADIO EXAMPLE

Traffic Stop **UNIT**, code six on a t-stop on **STREET**, vehicle is a **MODEL**, occupied **AMOUNT**, plate reads **PLATE**. Requesting **AMOUNT** backup unit(s).

Felony Stop **UNIT**, code six on a felony stop on **STREET**, vehicle is a **MODEL**, occupied **AMOUNT**, plate reads **PLATE**. Requesting assistance in L-TAC #.

Vehicle Pursuit **UNIT**, in pursuit of a **VEHICLE MODEL** going **DIRECTION** on **STREET**, requesting assistance (*optional: airship*) and a supervisor to A-TAC #

Foot Pursuit **UNIT**, in foot pursuit of a **DESCRIPTION SEX** headed **DIRECTION** on **STREET**. Requesting assistance (*optional: airship*) and a supervisor to A-TAC #.

Requesting Backup/Assistance **UNIT**, requesting **AMOUNT** backup units to **STREET** for **REASON**. / **UNIT**, requesting assistance to **STREET** for **REASON**.

Non-emergent response **UNIT**, responding to **UNIT's** backup request/last call for service in **ETA**.

SITUATION CHEAT SHEET (cont)

Emergent response **UNIT**, code to **UNIT's** assistance request/call for service in **ETA**.

Deputy involved Shooting **UNIT 998** at **LOCATION!**

Requesting an ambulance Sheriff's **UNIT** for Fire Metro. *wait for response UNIT*, requesting an RA unit to **LOCATION** for **RACE/BRIEF DESCRIPTION** suffering from **INJURIES**. **CONSCIOUS/UNCONSCIOUS** and **BREATHING/NOT BREATHING**.

Crime Broadcast Sheriff's **UNIT**. Clear the air for a crime broadcast. break **CRIME(S)** occurred at **TIME** on **STREET**. Vehicle is a **MODEL** occupied **AMOUNT** with plate reading **PLATE**. **DESCRIPTION OF SUSPECTS**, known to carry **FIREARM/NO WEAPONS KNOWN**. Last seen driving/running to **LOCATION**. No further details.
